

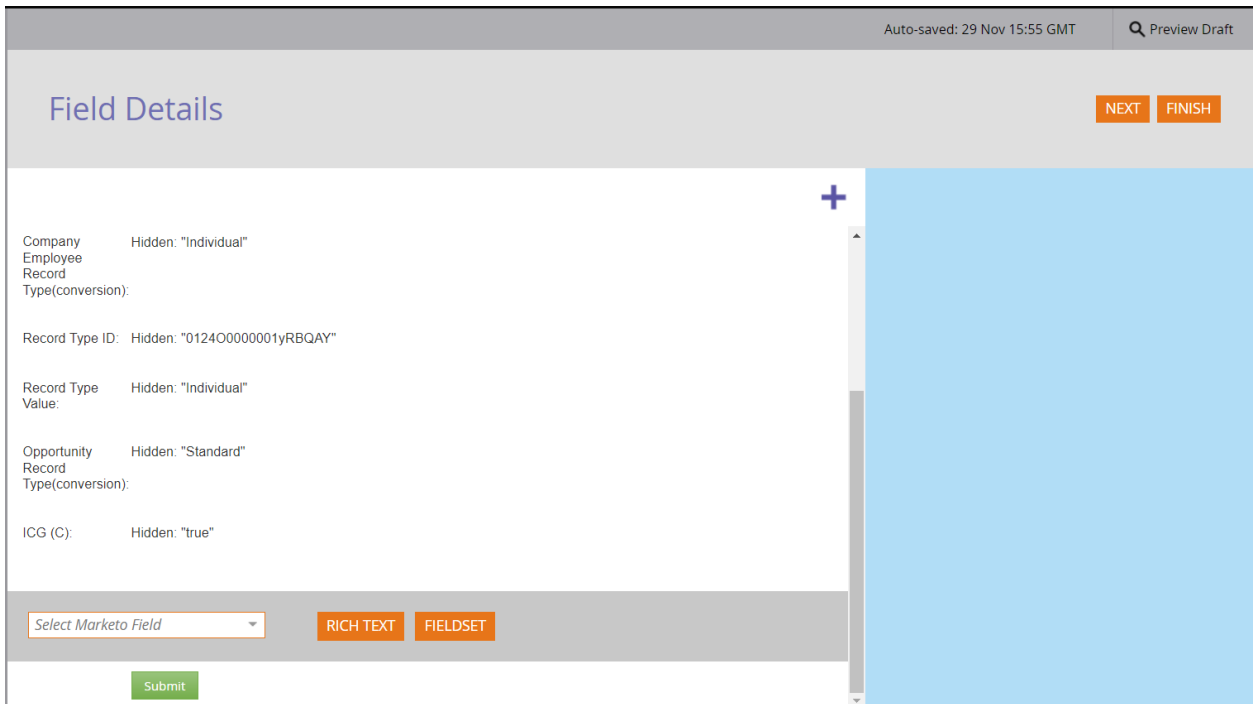
# To Restrict the personal email domains on Form

1. Enter the draft mode of form.

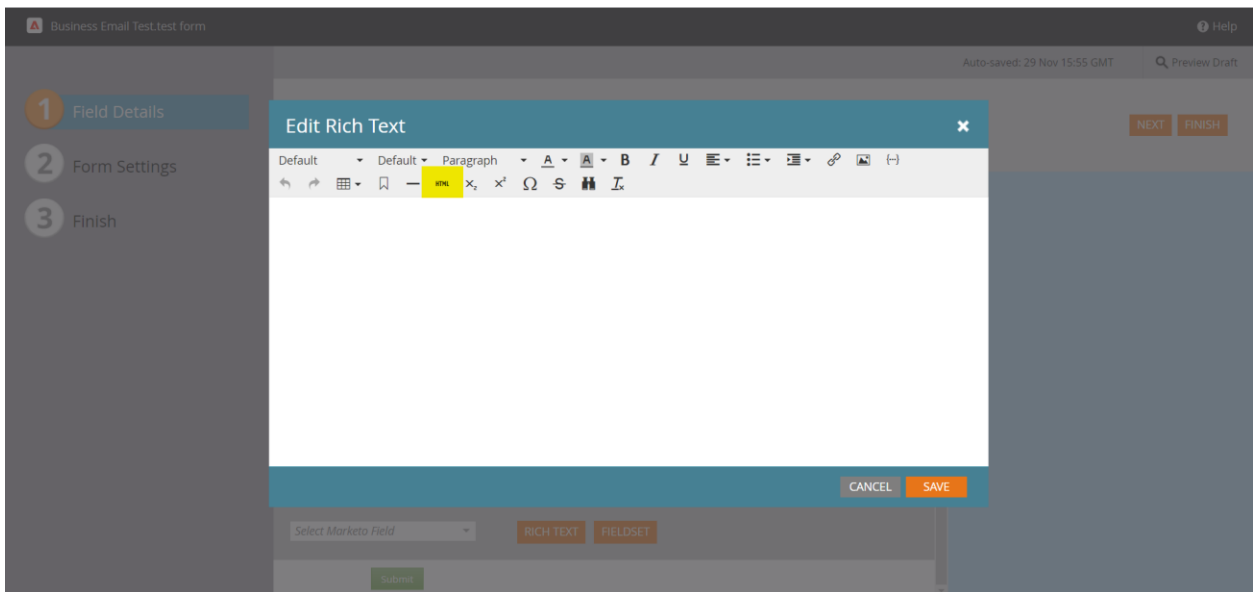

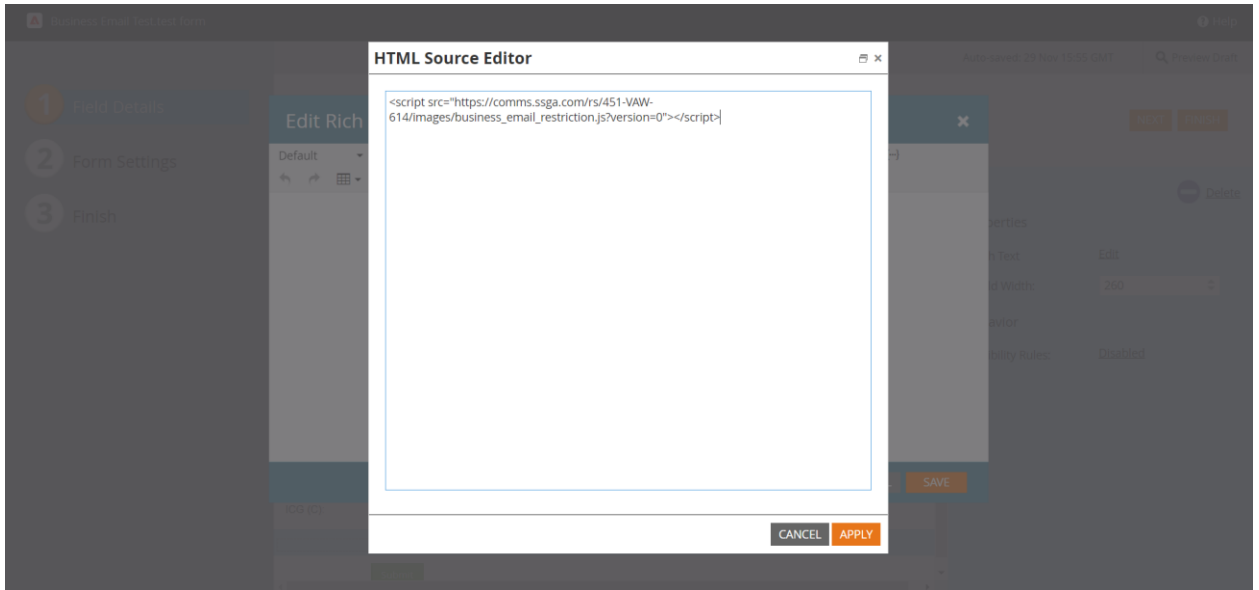


3. Edit Rich Text dialog box will appear. Now click on the **HTML** button on the toolbar.

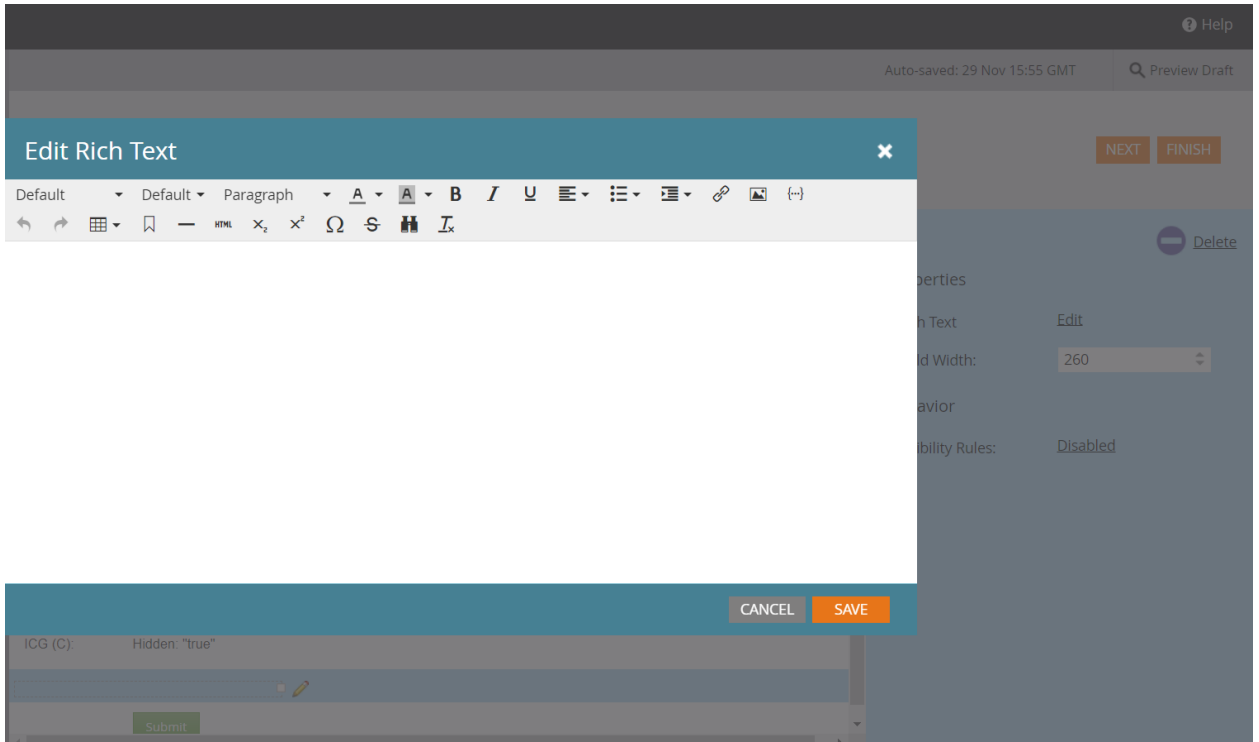


- HTML Source Editor box will popup. Copy the below mentioned script as it is and paste it in the HTML Source Editor and Click on APPLY button.
